Sub: Violation of the IMS Act by Infant Milk Substitute and Infant Food manufacturer Heinz & e-Commerce web portal shopClues.com (http://www.shopclues.com/heinz-cereals-4m-bf-125g-fruit-and-yogurt-cereal.html?ref=tm_bs_3)

Dear Sir,

I wish to bring this to your kind notice that e-Commerce portal **shopClues.com** is selling an Infant food product '**Heinz breakfast fruit with yogurt cereal**'. While doing so, Shop Clues and Heinz are violating the IMS act due to following reasons:-

- 1. The product label suggests use of this product at 4+ month's age. This is a violation of IMS Act which defines infant foods "means any food (by whatever name called) being marketed or otherwise represented as a complement to mother's milk to meet the growing nutritional needs of the infant after the age of six months and up to the age of two year"
- 2. The product is being promoted on the website with display of photograph of the container. It violates Section 3 (a) of IMS Act says, No person shall-"advertise, or take part in the publication of any advertisement, for the distribution, sale or supply of infant milk substitutes, feeding bottles or infant foods."
- 3. The product is being sold at a rebate of 8%. This violates section 4 (c) of IMS Act which says, No person shall "offer inducement of any other kind, for the purpose of promoting the use or sale of infant milk substitutes or feeding bottles or infant foods."

I request you to kindly take note of about said violations and take necessary action against the company.
